Monday 2nd February: Feast of the Presentation in the Temple, also known as **Candlemas**, when it is customary to bless candles for use in the church and the home. Candles may be left on a table near the altar to be blessed and then taken home after mass. Please make sure to have your name on your candles!

Tuesday 3rd February: St Blaise – the blessing of throats is a blessing for the fullness of health and strength of mind and body. Two candles are held in the shape of the cross against the throat of the faithful with the words: *by the intercession of St Blaise, Bishop & Martyr, may God preserve you from all illness of the throat and from every other evil, in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.* The blessing will be given after Mass on Tuesday.

Pastoral Council Meeting took place last Wednesday. Matters addressed include - Stations of the Cross on the Mondays of Lent at 7pm with the participation of various parish groups; tea/coffee and hospitality after 11am Mass on the last Sunday of each month; a review of the parish cemetery policy to begin in conjunction with the Finance Committee to assess remaining capacity and make plots available to parishioners on a fair and equal basis in light of growing population and a limited amount of space remaining. Next meeting of the PPC on 11th March.

First Communion preparation continues with our **Grow in Love** programme at the Vigil & 11am Mass on 7th/8th February for those in second class preparing for First Confession and First Holy Communion this year.
