The **National Board for Safeguarding Children** in Ireland (NBSCCCI) has published a revised version of the *Safeguarding Children Policy* and associated guidance material.

This was adopted by the Irish Episcopal Conference on 11th June.

The Meath Diocesan Safeguarding Children Committee has organised information sessions, in association with the NBSCCCI, to brief clergy and parish safeguarding representatives on the revised documentation.

Sessions take place in Navan on 3rd September; Tullamore 4th September, Mullingar 10th September starting at 7pm, for approximately 90 minutes. Parish Reps are asked to attend.
