Our new Parish Priest is a native of Dalkey, Co Dublin, ordained in 1997 he has served as curate in Kinnegad and Kilcloon, as PP in Kilbeg and then for the past twelve years in Johnstown/Walterstown. In addition to the role of Pastor of Ratoath he will be Administrator of the neighbouring parishes of Curragha and Ardcath/Clonalvey which will be served by Fr Johanna and the newly appointed Curate Fr Roy George Vattakkatu from Kerala in India who has been chaplain to the growing Syro-Malabar community in our diocese and in Dublin for the past five years.
