## Weekday Mass Intentions

Mass in all the parishes of our Pastoral Area will be offered for victims and survivors of abuse in the Church.

**‘Shrove’ Tuesday** – years ago no eggs, butter or dairy produce could be eaten in Lent and so they were used up in the making of pancakes, hence *Pancake Tuesday*. ‘Shrove’ comes from the verb ‘to shrive’, meaning ‘to forgive’, as people started to prepare for their annual confession before Easter.

## ASH WEDNESDAY - DAY OF FASTING & ABSTINENCE

**Fasting** means we significantly reduce the amount we eat. **Abstinence** means no meat in any form. So, on Ash Wednesday we have only one main meal & two light meals, with nothing in between! Fasting applies from the age of 18 until 60, those 14 and over should abstain from meat. As with all penance, it is a question of forgoing something good for the sake of a higher good, which is the Kingdom of Heaven and the service of the poor.

The **Trocaire** campaign will be launched on the First Sunday of Lent and Trocaire boxes available at the church.

## Ash Wednesday – Mass and Imposition of Ashes at 9.45am and 7pm

There will be prayer services and distribution of ashes in the parish schools on Wednesday
