New Boards of Management in our Primary Schools.

The term of the present boards of management will conclude at the end of November and new boards will begin their four year term on 1st December 2023.

Each board is made up of 8 people – two patron representatives, the principal and one elected member of the teaching staff, two parents (a mother and a father) and two community representatives. We thank all the members of the outgoing Boards in Ratoath Junior NS; Ratoath Senior NS; Rathbeggan NS and St Paul's NS and we wish the members of the new boards every good wish as they

take up office.

In a letter sent to the outgoing board, the Patron, Bishop Deenihan thanked the out-going board for their commitment and service to the school, parish and to Catholic education.

He noted that in the past four years the Boards had to deal with

the Covid 19 crises, which presented a relentless series of challenges to schools from March 2020; the ongoing shortage of teachers;

the challenges of adequately funding our schools;

extending services to assist children with additional educational needs

and the ever increasing legislative oversight.

Many schools too had other concurrent challenges to deal with including bereavements, traumatic incidents, adjudicating disputes, managing building projects, declining pupil numbers and adapting to changes in leaderships.

The **Parish Pastoral Assembly** will meet this Wednesday 29th November at 7.30pm in the Parish Pastoral Centre.

Last week, priests from the 69 parishes of our Diocese met in Cavan to begin a process of reflection on the future of priestly ministry and pastoral life in parishes in the Diocese of Meath.

During this assembly, new models of parish life, possible collaborations among parishes, the provision of sacraments, personnel and resources, faith formation and the welfare of priests were considered in the context of the mission of the Church and the desire to sustain vibrant faith communities.

The establishment and supporting of Parish Pastoral Assemblies was deemed a necessary structure in every parish. It was also agreed that there would have to be consultation and engagement with local Pastoral Assemblies before any developments occur.

The **sick and the housebound** will be attended to in their homes on Thursday of this week.

The **40 hours of Adoration** in the Cathedral of Christ the King, Mullingar will conclude with Solemn Vespers and Benediction at 4.00pm this Sunday 26th November. All are welcome.
