From the address of Pope Francis at the Angelus last Sunday

God is merciful. His justice is merciful. Let us allow ourselves to be taken by the hand by Him.

We too, disciples of Jesus, are required to exercise justice in this way, in relationships with others, in the Church, in society: not with the harshness of those who judge and condemn, *dividing* people into good and bad, but with the mercy of those who welcome by *sharing* the wounds and frailties of their sisters and brothers, so as to lift them up.

I would like to put it like this: not dividing, but sharing. Not dividing, but sharing.

Let us do as Jesus did: let us share, let us carry each other's burdens instead of gossiping and destroying, let us look at each other with compassion, let us help each other.

Let us ask ourselves: am I a person who divides or shares?

Think a little: am I a disciple of Jesus' love or a disciple of gossip, that divides.

Gossip is a lethal weapon: it kills, it kills love, it kills society, it kills fraternity.
