Diocese of Minna: Nigeria:

Early last Sunday morning at about 3am, in Nigeria's Niger State, a group of bandits attacked the parish residence of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Kafin-Koro, Paikoro region. The bandits set fire to the house and the attack caused the death of Father Isaac Achi, the parish priest.

Upon the arrival of security forces at the scene, the bandits fled, setting the house on fire from which Father Achi was unable to flee. The unknown assailants also shot and wounded Father Collins Omeh, who remains in hospital but is responding to treatment.

The Catholic Diocese of Minna released a statement later in the day calling for prayers for the Diocese and for the quick recovery of Fr. Collins.

Please pray for Fr Achi, who is from the same diocese of Minna that Fr Yohanna is from.

Fr Yohanna is currently in Nigeria and Fr Gerry has sent his condolences to Fr Yohanna on behalf of the people of the parish on the tragic death of his colleague.

At the General Audience in Rome last Wednesday, Pope Francis said

"I ask all of you to join me in praying for Father Isaac Achi, of the Diocese of Minna in northern Nigeria, who was killed last Sunday in an attack on his rectory.

So many Christians continue to be the target of violence: let us remember them in our prayers."
