Parish Secretary is a role that has evolved considerably in recent years from that of receptionist to an indispensable administrative position in a modern parish office setting. In particular it leaves the priest free of many unnecessary desk duties in order to focus on pastoral care and engaging with people and their needs. The role of secretary involves being the 'welcoming face' of the parish, taking calls, replying to emails, keeping the parish diary and mass bookings, and also considerable IT skills such as online banking, Surf accounts, Word and Excel, spreadsheets, and managing the parish data base.

The enhanced position will be re-advertised in the new year on a 4 day basis from 9.30am – Ipm. For the convenience of parishioners (and that of the PP!) this is a position that needs to be filled by the right, skilled person as soon as possible in a parish as active and busy as ours.
