

Feast of the Lateran – an unusual feast occurs this Sunday, that of the *Dedication of the Lateran Basilica*! Though St Peter's and the Vatican are long associated with the Pope the actual Cathedral church of Rome, where the Pope has his *cathedra* or official seat as Bishop of Rome, is that of *St John Lateran* and the Popes lived in the adjacent Lateran Palace from the 5th to 15th century. So, we are celebrating the primacy of the Pope by honouring the church in which is the *cathedra* or *seat* from which he derives his divine and apostolic authority.

Pastoral Letter - The Future of our Parishes: Bishop Dennihan's Pastoral Letter is addressed to all the clergy and faithful of the diocese. It emphasizes the importance of the parish structure, the implementation of the new Pastoral Areas, the provision of Sunday Mass, and plans for a future with a very different profile of clergy and changed demographics. All priests of the diocese gather this week for a conference on the implementation of the Pastoral Area structures and new Deaneries. 40 Hours Adoration: To celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, there will be 40 Hours Adoration in the Cathedral, starting with Mass at 7:30 pm on Friday 21st November and concluding with Solemn Vespers and Benediction at 4 pm on Sunday 23rd. Our parish has been allocated the time of 3pm or 4pm on Saturday 22nd. Confessions will be heard from 12 noon to 12 midnight on Saturday. While each parish is assigned a particular hour of adoration, people are not restricted to their parish's hour. It is hoped that people from across the Diocese will come to the Cathedral during this time to pray for the Church, the diocese and our parish needs.

Pastoral Council Meeting – matters discussed include providing a cup of tea after the I Iam Mass on the First Sunday of Advent; the great success of the Grow-in-Love parish programme in preparation for First Confession and Communion, and a review of mass times, Carol Services etc for Christmas.

The **Annual Parish Child Safeguarding Audit** was done by the two Safeguarding Reps and the PP on Friday. The Diocese has a system of governance that identifies clear procedures, accountability structures and quality assurance, in which roles and responsibilities are explicit. This requirement is in accordance with the Church's revised safeguarding policy. The annual parish self-audit helps in reviewing the implementation of safeguarding policy, compliance with procedures and highlights additional areas where training is needed.

Cemetery Wall: reconstruction work has begun after the major damage caused some weeks ago. As much material as possible will be salvaged and reused. An insurance claim was submitted to cover the cost.
